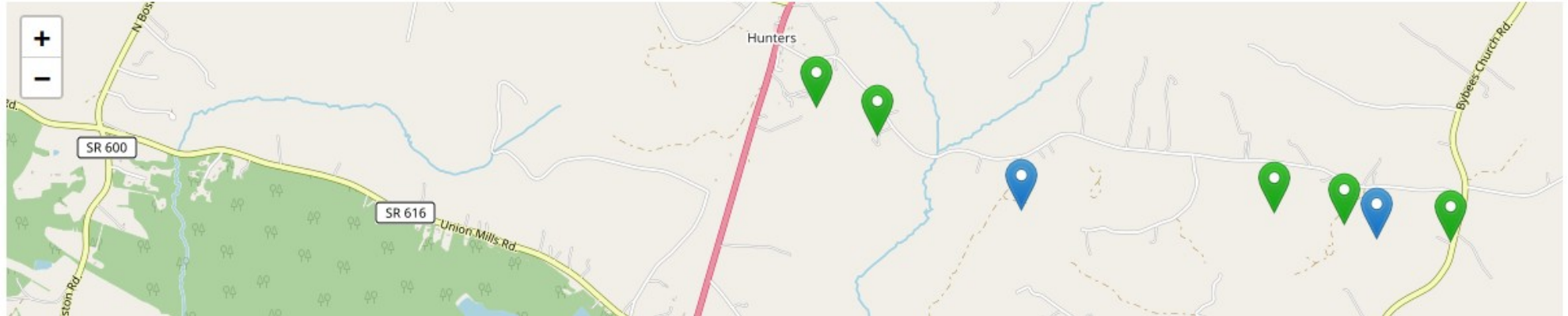
View Type:   Party:

- Select the workbook to be canvassed
- Select the View Type:
  - Map – displays the voters on a map
  - Voter List – displays a list of voters (upon clicking a voter, a form will be displayed which shows only one voter)
  - Address List – displays a list of addresses (upon clicking an address, a form will be displayed which shows all of the voters at that address)
  - Individual – displays a voter one at a time
- Select the Political Party (if available. This option is sometimes turned off by managers)
- Click Submit
- The map, lists or voter form will then be displayed

# Map Screen

## Voters

- Voters can be filtered by political party, city, street name or odd or even house numbers by selecting the appropriate filter and clicking Go.
- Voters are displayed on the map as pins.
- Pin colors are:
  - Green - Voter has not been contacted
  - Yellow - User has clicked on the voter and is viewing their information
  - Blue - Voter has been contacted
- Click on a pin to see the voter form.

- The call script is the script to be used when calling the voter, it optionally includes questions that can be answered for the address as a whole as well as questions to be answered for each voter
- Submit request will save the answers and move to the next address
- Next address moves to the next address in the walkbook without saving the answers
- Return to list returns to the list of addresses for this walkbook
